Resolutions

Recommends that UN-GGIM-AP:

- a) *Continues* to advocate and raise political awareness of the importance and urgency of geospatial information and statistics integration for developing nations in the region within the IGIF for the work of the 2020 Round of Censuses and the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development;
- b) *Supports and provides* assistance in implementing the integration through human capacity buildings, pilot projects and knowledge sharing through regional or international workshops and seminars;
- c) *Supports and facilitates* collaborations of the Working Group with other UN organization bodies e.g. the UN-GGIM Working Group on Geospatial Information and Services for Disasters, the Expert Group on the Integration of Statistical and Geospatial Information.
